

## Drive-in Banquet FAQs

**Why is the banquet at the Drive-in?** This unique venue allows us to have a large group gather for our Annual Banquet while maintaining social distancing for everyone's safety. Plus, it's fun!

**What will the program be like? Is it a movie?** Our banquet program will include stories of God at work in our Centers, a LIVE organization report, a message by our keynote speaker & more...all on the big screen!

**How will Table Sponsorship work?** Just like at our regular banquet, Table Sponsors are VIPS! Each Table Sponsor will be inviting 10 or more friends & family to join them. Please see Table Sponsor RSVP card.

**What does my \$25 ticket price cover?** Boxed dinner, beverages, unlimited popcorn, parking, program and a great evening of celebrating life and the ministry of Informed Choices.

**How early should I arrive?** Please arrive between 6:00-6:45 to pick-up your meal and find your assigned parking space

**Am I allowed to get out of my car?** Yes, but we ask you to stay in the area of your parking space.

- Please feel free to **BRING YOUR OWN CHAIRS** & sit in front of your vehicle. This way, you can visit with your friends while maintaining social distancing requirements.
- **Will I be able to hear if I sit outside my car?** Yes, there are several outdoor speakers, but if you wish you may bring a portable radio and listen at 89.9 fm.

**What's for dinner?** As you drive in, volunteers (masked & gloved) will give you a boxed dinner (gourmet turkey wrap, condiments, 3 sides & a brownie) as well as water and/or soft drink. Please note any dietary restrictions when you RSVP and we will do our best to accommodate them.

- **Will concession stand be open?** No, but water and soft drinks as well as unlimited popcorn will be brought around to your car.

**Will I be able to sit with my friends?** Yes! Please indicate who you would like to be parked near when you RSVP. We will be assigning parking spaces by registered groups & encourage you to bring chairs so you can visit during dinner.

**Can I bring my kids and/or dog?** We recommend you use extreme discretion as our program topic is for *"Mature Audiences Only"*. We ask you to leave furry friends at home.

**Will restrooms be available?** Yes! You will be required to wear a mask when in the restrooms.

**What safety COVID safety precautions will be in place?**

- You are welcome to stay in your car & listen to the entire program on FM radio
- Your program, dinner & beverage will be handed to you in your car by masked and gloved volunteers as you arrive.
- Only one vehicle will be allowed to park between two speaker poles. This will allow for a social distancing space of approximately 12' to 16'
- You must stay within the confines of your vehicle as much as possible. You may lay in the bed of your truck or in the back of a van. You may also sit in front of your vehicle. However, if you must get up and move around and/or enter the restrooms, you must be wearing a facemask.

**What happens if it rains?** We will post on our website 24 hours in advance if rain is predicted that will require us to have our event on the rain date of Tuesday, Sept. 29<sup>th</sup>.
